

Georgia-Pacific self-adhering all temperature (AT) flashing tape is a pressure sensitive adhesive-based product designed to adhere to construction surfaces without primer or conditioning. It is used for sealing openings and material transitions and provides protection from air and moisture. The tape is minimum 4" wide and 0.009" thick and meets or exceeds current AAMA 711 standards.
